This is a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act for information on Primary Care Talking Therapy Hubs.

Please provide the following information for the period April – December 2021:

Question 1 - No of referrals received.

A total of 2053 referrals to the service for the Period April – Dec 21 broken down as follows;

- AntrimBmena - 634
- Causeway - 421
- East Antrim - 795
- Mid Ulster – 203

Question 2 - Breakdown of waiting time data, measured from referral received from the GP to first appointment, as follows:

- i. Longer than 1 month –
- ii. Longer than 3 months
- iii. Longer than 6 months
- iv. Longer than 12 months
